- Advance reservations highly recommended; reservations required for Club due to meal service.
- Payment required at reservation.
- Parties in Club with separate reservations who wish to sit together must inform agent at time of reservation.
- Coach seating is first-come, first-served.
- All seating areas are enclosed.
- Observation cars available for all passengers. Must be at least 6 years old to ride in the gondola car.
- Parents must accompany children at all times.
- Dress for the weather.
- Wear proper footwear. High-heeled shoes, sandals, and flip-flops are not recommended.
- No alcohol or smoking permitted.
- Only service animals are permitted.
- All tickets are will-call. Pick up at the ticket office (blue caboose) prior to boarding.
- Please arrive 30—60 minutes prior to departure.
- Boarding begins 30 minutes prior to departure.
- Late arrivals cannot be guaranteed seating together.
- Restrooms available throughout the train.
- Trains depart on time.
- Safety first and always!



Cancellation Policy

Ticket sales are non-refundable. However, an in-house monetary credit can be held for a future excursion (subject to availability) for up to one year. For events with meal service, if cancellation is less than one week prior to departure date, a service fee will be charged.

Your journey begins at Wappocomo Station in Romney, West Virginia, situated next to a charming homestead with a sprawling view of the mountains. Enjoy the sounds of vintage diesels as they lead you through beautiful pastures and farms dating back to the 1700s.

As you wind along the South Branch of the Potomac River, you'll enter a visually striking canyon known as the Trough. One of the most scenic spots along the South Branch, the Trough is home to American bald eagles!

Classes of Service

Club and Coach are offered on all excursions.



Club includes meal service, complemented with Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad china. These beautifully restored lounge cars offer loveseats with tables and are climate controlled. Advance reservations required. Entree chosen at time of reservation.



Coach is great for families or groups as an affordable yet still comfortable seating option on the train.

Seats are cushioned, high-back, bench-style, with a reversible back. These 1920s era coaches have windows that may be opened but limited heat is also available. Advance reservations are highly recommended.

Excursions

Both southbound trips travel through the Trough, the six-mile-long canyon where bald eagles nest. All excursions depart Romney and are round-trip.

Trough Trip - our regular 3-hour trip southbound through the Trough to Sycamore Bridge. No layover. Approximately 35 miles round-trip.

All-Day Trip - last Saturday of each month (May to September). A longer version of the Trough Trip, this 8-hour trip goes further south, to the end of the line in Petersburg. There is a layover in Petersburg. Approximately 76 miles round-trip.

Green Spring Special - a northbound 1.5-hour trip. Enjoy river views along the South Branch of the Potomac River as well as beautiful farms and rock cuts. No layover. Approximately 25 miles round-trip.
